Canton Parks & Recreation Special Event COVID-19 Safety Protocol

Protocol is subject to change. Please check CantonRec.org for updates.

Additional safety guidelines may be assigned as needed.

All participants will be required to abide by the following guidelines in order to prioritize and maintain the health and safety of all participants, parents and staff.

Pre-Screening: All staff and participants will be asked to conduct health self-assessments prior to arrival at the event. Anyone presenting with any symptoms will be asked to remain at home.

- If the participant has a temperature over 100.4 degrees, persistent cough, or other indications of illness, please do not leave your home.
- Please wash your hands with soap and water to ensure safety of players, coaches, and staff.

PPE for attendees: All event attendees including, but not limited to, employees, volunteers and spectators, shall wear a facemask or cloth covering. Once inside their social distanced seating area, speaker and spectators will be able to remove their masks. Whenever moving outside of their seating, spectators must wear a facemask or cloth covering.

Check in: Attendees must check in with a staff member. After check in, the participant will be directed to their designated seating area.

During Event: Participants are asked to remain seated during the event. Whenever leaving your seating area a face covering must be worn and social distancing should be maintained.

Social Distancing: In a continued effort to keep participants and staff safe, social distance will be maintained wherever feasible. We ask that participants are mindful of their spacing when moving around the event space. Seating will be distanced according to State of CT Sector Rules.
