

MILLS POND PARK SPLASH PAD RULES & REGULATIONS

Area designed for children age 11 and under. Adult supervision is required

TO START SPLASH PAD: Locate the activator on top of the brown stand post

- Infants & toddlers must wear swim diapers. Do not change diapers or clothing on or around the splash pad area
- Shower in warm water & have children use the restroom before going into the splash pad. No bathing, soap, detergent or shampoo in the splash pad
- The water in the splash pad is recirculated and treated. Do not drink the water. Persons who have a contagious disease, have had diarrhea within the last 2 weeks, have nausea, skin or eye irritations or infections, have respiratory infections, open lesions, cuts or wounds are prohibited from using the splash pad
- Spitting & nose blowing is prohibited on & around the splash pad
- Please play in a courteous, safe & family oriented manner. Unruly, disruptive behavior, running, rough housing & foul language will not be tolerated
- Slip-resistant water shoes are recommended at all times for all guests on & around the splashpad. Street shoes are prohibited
- Toys, bubbles & other outside equipment are not permitted in the splash pad area
- No climbing on splash pad elements or jumping off benches
- Mills Pond Park is alcohol, smoke, tobacco & weapon free. No food or drinks (other than water) allowed on or around the splash pad area. No glass bottles or objects allowed. Dispose of all trash properly
- Bicycles, scooters, skateboards, roller blades, skates of any kind, strollers or any other type of wheeled vehicle, with the exception of wheelchairs and assistive devices, are prohibited on & around the splash pad area
- No pets allowed on &/or around the splash pad area
- In case of thunderstorm, lightning, or severe weather of any kind, vacate the splash pad immediately and seek shelter. Splash pad will remain closed until 30 minutes after the last thunder is heard
- The shade area & benches are meant to be shared, not reserved
- Any organized group looking to visit the splash pad must contact the Canton Parks & Recreation Department office at 860-693-5808 in advance of its visit. Facility request forms or certificates of liability insurance may be required

Splash pad may be closed at any time due to weather, reservations, maintenance or other concerns. Use of the splash pad is at your own risk

For general safety, the splashpad is under video camera surveillance and is regularly monitored
